## PRIVACY INFORMATION

We wish to inform you that Legislative Decree N. 196, 30 June 2003 ("Code concerning the protection of personal data") provides for the protection of persons and other subjects regarding the processing of personal data.

According to the law, this processing will be based on principles of correctness, lawfulness and transparency and the protection of your privacy and your rights. Under Article 13 of Legislative Decree N. 196/2003, we inform you that:

### 1. PURPOSE OF PROCESSING

The processing that we intend to carry on data supplied by you shall be carried out for:

a) implementation of services required (reservations)

### 2. METHOD OF PROCESSING

The processing shall be affected with manual and/or automatic systems used to memorize, manage and transmit the data, with logic strictly related to the purposes for which they were collected, however, to ensure the security and confidentiality of data and in accordance with Article 11, paragraph 1 of D. Lgs. N. 196, 30 June 2003.

Please note that at any moment you can request the confirmation of the existence of his personal data and to know its content and origin, verify its accuracy or request its integration, updating or rectification (art. 7, Legislative Decree 196/2003).

Under the same Article shall have the right to request cancellation, transformation into anonymous form or blocking of data processed in violation of the law, and to oppose in any case, for legitimate reasons, their processing. ### 3. OPTIONAL NATURE OF DATA AND CONSEQUENCES OF POSSIBLE REFUSAL TO ANSWER
